PUBLIC HEARING

This was a continuance of the Public Hearing from the November 11, 2019 regarding the rezone request Melba Valley Market Rezone

Mayor Dickard offered information from a phone conversation with Chuck Pavelka, Building Official regarding the information he is requiring for inspections to be completed. Mayor suggested a meeting with Mr. George, Building Official can meet on weekends and after 6:30 pm. Mr. Pavelka agreed to contact Mr. George to set up a meeting.

Mr. Pavelka commented he needs a set of working plans to know what he is inspecting. Mr. Pavelka's request is supported by the City's adopted Building Code.

City Attorney advised Council should not be arbitrator for the interpretation of the Building Code.

Mr. Pavelka commented that if the issue cannot be resolved there is a process prescribed in Building Code for mediation of an issue; he commented he had not had to use the process in his 20 years as a Building Official.

Mr. George needs to provide a set of plans and obtain a permit for the work to be inspected.

With no other comments from Council or Building Official Council closed the Public Having and accepted Melba Planning and Zoning Commission's Findings of Fact and Recommendation for approval by motion from Hinderliter; 2nd by Stapleton.

After deliberation on this issue Council directed Staff to draft Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Order allowing 120 days for Mr. George to submit plans as conditioned in the Melba Planning & Zoning Commission's Findings of Fact and Recommendation as accepted by motion from Hinderliter; 2nd by Stapleton. A. Canyon County Clerk's certification of election results for the November 5, 2019 Election was accepted by motion from Hinderliter; 2nd by Forsgren.

Results: Melba had 222 registered voters; 23 Ballots were cast; 2 absentee ballots received; percent of voters voting 10.4%. Jeannine Johnshoy retained her seat with 21 votes; Write-In Tyler Stapleton received 6 votes.

- **B.** City Attorney Houston presented a draft Memo of Understanding between the City of Melba and Melba Valley Senior Center for use of the former Library Building at City Park for a Thrift Store. After review, the draft was accepted, Council directed City Clerk to forward Memo of Understanding to Melba Valley Senior Center Board for review and signature. Draft a Resolution to authorize Mayor's signature for the January 13, 2020 City Council meeting by motion from Stapleton; 2nd by Forsgren. Motion Carried
- C. It was the consensus of the Council not to amend Melba City Code 3-1-11 Liquor Control-Days and Hours of Sales at this time.
- **D.** Council reviewed and accepted Melba Planning & Zoning Commission's Findings of Fact and Recommendations for Annexation 2019-01-Jon Mortensen. A Public Hearing date was set for Monday, January 13, 2020 at 7:00 pm at Melba City Hall by motion from Hinderliter; 2nd by Stapleton. Motion Carried.

- B. City Attorney Kirk Houston Did not have any additional items at this time.
- C. City Engineer Mike Davis reported
 - Is preparing for the 11 month meeting to conduct a walkover of the Drinking Water System Project. Requested attendees include Mike Davis, City Engineer, Mayor Dickard, USDA-RD representatives and Public Works Supt., Darrell Romine. The meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, December 18, 2019, 9:30 am to 11:00 am.
 - Mr. Davis reported the Local Rural Highway Improvement Program (LRHIP) grant application for chip sealing has been submitted December 2, 2019. The funding is for project completed in the Fiscal Year 2020-2021, the City will need to expend the \$25,000 budgeted and the \$11,200 received from Warrington to chip seal the areas Warrington cut and repaired for new distribution lines this year, but it was included in the application to show the City's use of their own funds.
 - The City should be receiving response comments from Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC) regarding the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) application for the improvements on Carrie Rex Ave from 4th St. to 2nd St submitted November 8, 2019 for pre-screening of the application soon. The full complete application is due February 2, 2020.

- Once the property owner is in agreement with the Business Sign Mr. Davis will prepare the written legal description for the easement; a lease can then be drafted. Mayor Dickard will contact Mr. Jameson this week.
- **D.** Public Works Supt., Darrell Romine reported equipment has been moved in on the Charlotte Dr. property for demolition, Mr. Dice will place construction fence around work area. Public Works Supt. Romine has been reviewing the camera logs from the hydro clean and video of the sewer lines.
